



Sir Mokshagundam Visvesvaraya

Born: 15 September 1861

Died: 12 April 1962

Sir Mokshagundam was an Indian engineer, scholar, statesman, and the 19th Diwan of Mysore, who served from 1912 to 1918. He received India's highest honor, the Bharat Ratna, in 1955. He was knighted as a Knight Commander of the British Indian Empire

(KCIE) by King George V for his contributions to the public good. 15 September is celebrated as Engineer's Day in India in his memory. He is held in high regard as a pre-eminent Engineer of India. He was chief engineer responsible for the construction of the Krishna Raja Sagara dam in Mandya district and chief engineer of the flood protection system for the city of Hyderabad.


